The DRB1\*01 primer set is unchanged compared to the previous Olerup SSP® DRB1\*01 (Lot No. 9E8).

### **ALLELE COVERAGE:**

DRB1\*01:01 to DRB1\*01:89, i.e. all the currently recognized DRB1\*01 alleles, will be amplified by the primers in the DRB1\*01<sup>1</sup> subtyping kit; [www.ebi.ac.uk/imgt/hla](http://www.ebi.ac.uk/imgt/hla), 2018-July-11, release 3.33.0.

The DRB1\*01 kit enables separation of the confirmed DRB1\*01 alleles as listed in the IMGT/HLA database 3.26.0. An HLA allele is listed as confirmed by IMGT/HLA if it has been sequenced by more than a single laboratory or from multiple sources.

The DRB1\*01 kit also enables identification of null and alternatively expressed alleles.

The following DRB1\*01 alleles can be distinguished by the different sizes of the HLA-specific PCR product:
